Works Update

Council crews have been busy completing:

Tree pruning, including canopy uplifts and powerline clearance across Benalla and rural townships.

- Road slashing at town entrances.
- Roadside spraying, including gutter spraying and noxious weed control.
- Refreshed line-marking at intersections throughout Benalla and rural areas.
- Footpath replacement in Mackellar Street.

Asphalt resurfacing have been completed in:

- Thomas Street (between Waller and Cowan streets)
- Ackerly Avenue (at the

roundabout and near the level crossing)

- Witt Street (near the level crossing)
- The intersection of Benalla and Nunn streets
- Eastern side of the Denny Street carpark (above pic)
- Faithful Street kerb with channel works continuing.

Roads to Recovery Program

As part of the 2023/24 Road Resurfacing Program, the following roads have been completed in Stage One of the program:

- Arundel Street (from Bridge Street to Neil Avenue)
- Cecil Street (from Showgrounds Gate 1 to Arundel Street)
- Deas Street (from Gardens entry to Arundel Street)
- Dunlop Place (from Arundel Street to end)
- Garden Street (from Arundel Street to Benson Street)
- Lakeview Close (from Arundel Street to end)
- Samaria Road (from Bridge Street to Kilfeera Road)
- Wedge Street (from Arundel Street to Gardens entrance)
- Benalla-Warrenbayne Road (from Dobson Road to School Road)
- School Road (from Benalla-Warrenbayne Road to Stow Road)
- Sessions Road (from Whites Road to end of seal (Hurrell Road))
- Stow Road (from School Road to end of seal).
